

### **PPiP2** updates

This month we interviewed SINAPPS2 Oxford RA Sally-Anne about her experience in PPiP2. Sally-Anne has recently became actively involved in PPiP2 in the Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust, and below she is sharing some interesting insights!

I have recently been actively presenting the PPiP2 study in different teams around Oxfordshire and Buckinghamshire in order to promote the study and help boost recruitment. With a high turnaround in staff, I have particularly noticed that most people are not actually familiar with PPiP2 and, therefore, we feel it is very important for researchers/CSOs to regularly attend these meetings in order to ensure the study has not been forgotten about. I have noticed that the wards seem to be the best place to find potential participants so definitely visit the wards to recruit patients into PPiP2. Good luck with the recruitment!

#### SINAPPS2 updates

We are delighted to welcome the Clinical Research Facility team from Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust on the SINAPPS2 trial team! Researchers from this Mental Health Trust are already recruiting for PPiP2 and their involvement in the SINAPPS2 is going to be a new and exciting experience for all of us.

The CRF team, based at the Warneford Hospital (pictured below), will provide the IVIG/placebo infusions to SINAPPS2 participants. This will be excellent opportunity to explore research collaborations between mental health and acute hospital services.
